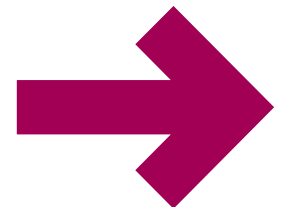


“Good format for day. Very interesting for hearing the patient perspective, but also hear about broad issues”
