Electronic Referral System Update	<p>Work is proceeding according to the project plan; Chief Officers of the 3 Collaborative Commissioning Groups within Y&H have been informed of this project and to seek their approval and support the team have also been liaising with the IT Developer from Manchester regarding software and implementation costs. Chris Gale from Leeds University has also been contacted regarding hosting arrangements and he has agreed to explore the feasibility of this and to identify any resulting cost implications. Next steps include liaising with LTHT regarding their newly installed electronic referral system and to present the final version of the options appraisal paper / business case to the 3 Collaborative CCG Groups for their endorsement. 7.	Missed Opportunities Project Update	Missed Opportunities research project ongoing, currently awaiting decision of Network funding from DOH.	Ged Oliver
8.	Complex Devices – Presentation of Preliminary Findings & Discussion	<p>Presentation by Giles Ratcliffe attached to email.</p> <p>Shirley Ceairns expressed the need to understand referrals and come up with best model and best fit.</p> <p>Complex Devices is one of the top 3 priorities that NHS England is working on. Under provision is clear and an increase in provision is required in areas where there is less. NHS England understand that this must be addressed and are looking into current issues within the pathways and inequity. Concerns were raised that clinicians have been waiting over two years for this issue to be resolved. Clinicians argued that the data does not show any evidence of over provision just variable degrees of underprovision.</p> <p>CCG's are currently evaluating data from 2013/14 and comparing with data from 2014/15 to check for patterns and see if there has been a relevant shift and will continue to do this. Looking at current providers it is very difficult to put a definitive timeline on this piece of work. Shirley Ceairns stated that NHSE have no plans to decommission any existing commissioned centres based on the data presented but was unable to give any indication of when a decision would be made about any additional centres.</p> <p>The next milestone for this review is end of September. Action: Shirley Ceairns will keep the group updated with any major transitions.</p> <p>Peter Braidley advised that whichever providers cannot offer the devices should start logging deaths whilst on waiting lists as SUIs (serious untoward incidents).</p> <p>Rob Bain suggested that Devices should come under Localised Commissioning for speedier process and response times.</p>
