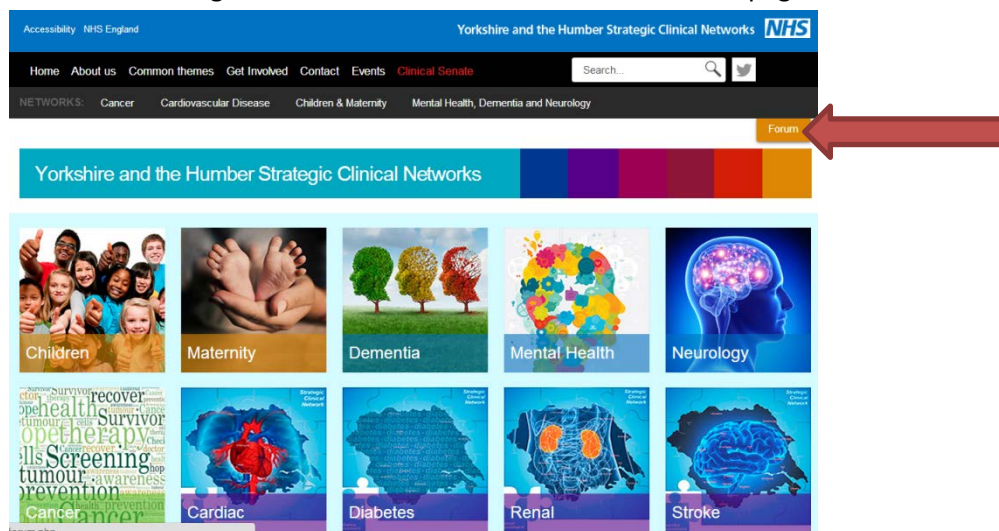


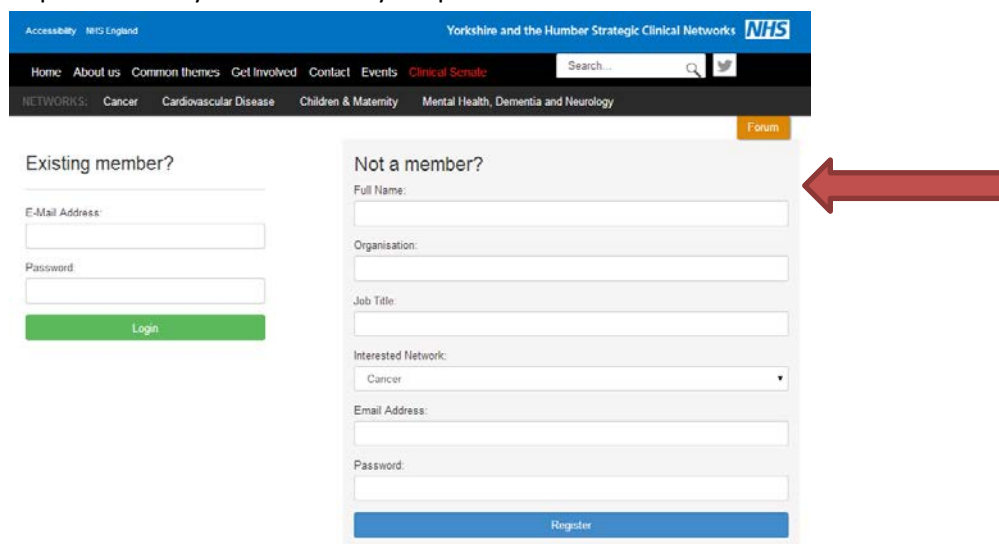
## Dementia SCN Forum Sign up Guidance

To sign up to the dementia leads forum:

1. Visit [www.yhscn.nhs.uk](http://www.yhscn.nhs.uk)
2. Click on the orange Forum button on the left hand side of the page.






3. If you are an existing member, log in. If not, please fill out the detail on the left hand side. It is important that you remember your password!


